Quilts to hang at the show.

We only have 215 quilts registered at the moment. This is way down and we need some more quilts. So if you have procrastinated about filling in those forms, please do so and let Norita or Sharon know. Don't forget to include the various guild challenges, the stripe challenge, 5 inch squares, bags, mystery.

Also I thought we could add a vintage section to the show, so if you have vintage quilts that you would like to share, please fill out the registration form, in triplicate, and bring that along with the quilts to hang on the 18th. Be sure to include as much history as you know on the quilt. Also, if you are planning on having this quilt in the quilt turning, it can still hang in the show and then be taken down prior to the turning,

as this is the last seminar on Sunday this will work out fine. Belinda needs to know ahead of time if you will have a quilt in the turning as of at the moment she only has 3 quilts. This is a quilt show, we need quilts!!

We will be hanging quilts a little differently this year, all of one person's quilts will be hung together unless it is one of the challenge or vintage quilts. Thought we would give this a try this year and see how we like it.

If you signed up to help hang on the 18th, remember we need ladders and a few wagons would be nice. We start hanging at 9 am, you can come at 8:30 and register your own quilts prior to starting to hang. If anyone knows the whereabouts of the "Please do not touch the Quilts" signs, please make sure they get to the Swiftel Center on the 18th and let me know that you have them.
